IMPORTANT NOTES

- (1) Sunfield can only claim a tax refund on donations made from your own personal taxable income. It does not apply to donations which are made by you on behalf of other people, or which comprises monies collected by you from a group of people, unless they have signed a declaration in their own right. Similarly tax can not be reclaimed from the proceeds of a fundraising event.
- (2) To qualify for Gift Aid, what you pay in income tax or capital gains tax must at least equal the amount we claim in the tax year from the Inland Revenue in regard to your donations.
